
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






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ATEITH MAIN SCOPE -1





1. Data analysis

- Bibliography search for other studies relevant to the project and preparation of review of the literature.
- Preparation of advanced word processing documents with draft chapters of research summaries and content for the final publication.
- Overview of project reports and articles and existing research into a comprehensive document.
- Collaboration of the project scientific supervisor of the ATEI of Thessaloniki with other scientists in data analysis for project use and publication content.





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

- These doctors and the auxiliary staff (driver and secretary contact person) will provide health services to the Project's target groups ten times in 10 different areas (eligible areas) (Table 1).
- Each trip will last two days. Therefore, the total operation of the Mobile Unit will be 20 days.



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Work Package 6 (cont.)

- The Project manager on behalf of ATEITH is a Medical Doctor (Gynecologist) with specialization in the field of Breast Cancer
- He will be responsible for the overall implementation of this activity
- Apart from his organizational responsibilities, Prof. Zafrakas will provide medical services to the Project's target group (elder women)
- Specifically, he will examine and inform women regarding breast cancer
